RE: DISTRICT CONVENTIONS

The 2020 election is already shaping up to be an exciting season. We will have a great slate of statewide and legislative candidates - and Dem-NPLers across the state are getting excited and getting organized to win in November 2020!

We are very excited for the ND Democratic-NPL State Convention in Minot on March 19-22! Head to www.demnpl.com for more information on the State Convention.

The district conventions are held to elect delegates and alternates to the State Convention, to nominate legislative candidates (*if applicable*), and to recommend items to the state convention committee on Platform and Resolutions for consideration to be adopted into the official Dem-NPL Platform.

A few important notes:

1. Your convention must be scheduled to take place between January 19 and February 27
2. You must provide notice to the State Party at least 20 days prior to your convention
3. Legal notice **must** be printed in the local county paper at least 10 days prior to your convention
4. You **must** also provide notice to the district committee (district officers, legislators (if any), past legislative candidates, potential candidates interested in securing the district nomination, and any other interested parties) at least 20 days prior to your convention
5. What you should bring to the district convention: packet from State Party; agenda; convention rules; ballots; forms for delegates and alternates; writing utensils

Thank you for your patience and attention to detail throughout this process. Your work as a District Chair is integral to the work we do as a state party – and we appreciate you!
